- 2) nqha clear , not having a dense growth of tree
- 3) nqhuab to become dry or evaporate

Additional Vocabulary and Pronunciation

- 4) Nqhuab = nos qos hos nqhos (nqh) + (ua) + (b) = nqhuab evaporate
- 5) Nqhis = nos qos hos nqhos (nqh) + (i) + (s) = nqhis thirsty
- 6) Nqha = nos qos hos nqhos (nqh) + (a) = nqha clear

Text Translation
